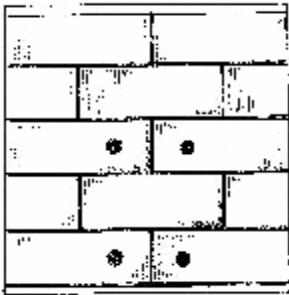
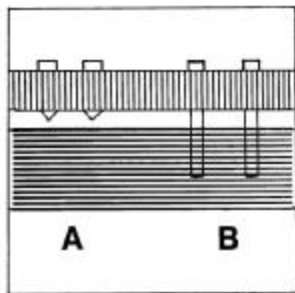


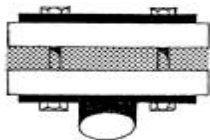
Fixing and Erection of Wall Mounted Flagpoles



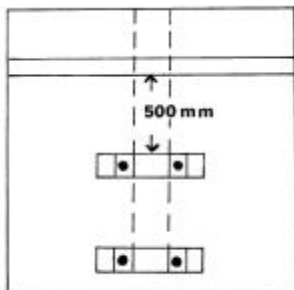

1. Use a secure mobile platform or ladder to access the fixing points.
2. Mark the wall in the correct positions for drilling (Diagram i).
3. Drill wall in correct positions for bracket(s).
4. Descend on the mobile platform or ladder.
5. Fit the top, halyard and cleat to the pole.
6. Take the flagpole bracket and pole to the wall using the mobile platform or ladder and secure with rawbolts (Diagram ii, A).
7. Where a back wall is to be considered and is of hard construction (concrete) it is advisable to drill through into the back wall and resin anchor the bolts used for fixing (Diagram ii, B).
8. Where a back wall is to be considered and is of soft construction (breeze/plaster). A back plate will be required (Diagram iii).
9. Please ensure that any upper bracket or angled wall bracket is never less than 500mm from the top of the wall (Diagram iv).
10. Rig flag to halyard, hoist flag to end of pole and fasten halyard to cleat.
